Mercury, Chicago's Skyline Cruiseline Kicks Off 2024 Season with New Tour Offering

Creepy Cruise to feature stories of mysterious sightings, haunted places, Chicago lore

CHICAGO — In a sure sign of summer approaching, <u>Mercury, Chicago's Skyline Cruiseline</u> returns to Chicago waterways on May 24 to launch its 89th season.

The new season brings a brand-new offering: the Creepy Cruise. Departing after dark on weekend evenings, the cruise features stories narrated by lively local tour guides of mysterious sightings, creepy haunts, mobsters and more. The nighttime tour will give guests the chance to cruise the Chicago River amidst twilight tales of the city.

Additional popular Mercury offerings include family-friendly daytime and evening cruises on the Chicago River and Lake Michigan, including Urban Adventure, 3D Fireworks, Chicago By Night! and Canine cruises. The cruises feature 360-degree, selfie-worthy views of the city's famous skyline and unparalleled views of iconic landmarks and skyscrapers, old and new—from the Willis Tower and Marina City to the St. Regis Chicago.

To further enhance accessibility for guests, Mercury Cruises will continue its offering of complimentary language translation services. Guests will have the opportunity to listen to a prerecorded tour narration on their smartphone in four different languages, including Spanish, French, Japanese and Korean. The translation service is accessible by downloading a free app that connects directly to a special wi-fi network onboard. The narration is triggered based on the location of the vessel at that time in the tour's route, which will help ensure those who use the technology have a similar experience as others listening to live narration.

Mercury Cruises, a fourth-generation family-owned and operated cruise line, has long been an important fixture in the city's cultural landscape, serving as a lakefront respite for locals and tourists. The original Mercury company, a single speedboat operation founded by Portuguese immigrant Arthur Agra in the 1930s, was a fast success and became Chicago's first sightseeing boat company. Mercury Cruises is a cornerstone of Chicago's Riverwalk, offering city, regional and cross-country visitors front-row seats to the city's breathtaking skyline.
